SPECIFIC AWARD CATEGORY CRITERIA

Ted Marshall Memorial Lifesaver of the Year

Outstanding contribution and performance in relation to all aspects of lifesaving. This person will be seen as role model for surf lifesavers. This person would have outstanding lifesaving work within the club or Branch at any level.

Volunteer of the year

Outstanding contribution and performance in relation to all aspects of lifesaving. This person will be seen as role model for volunteers. This person would have outstanding volunteer work within the club or Branch at any level.

Youth Life Saver of the Year

Outstanding contribution and performance in relation to all aspects of lifesaving. This person will be seen as role model for 14 to 18 yrs surf lifesavers. This person would have outstanding lifesaving work within the club or Branch at any level.

Competition Official of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to lifesaving officiating at an international and/or national and/or state and/or branch level.

Female Junior Athlete of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to competition performances at national and/or state and/or branch level by a junior female member of a club.

Male Junior Athlete of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to competition performances at national and/or state and/or branch level by a junior male member of a club.

Female Athlete of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to competition performances at an international and/or national and/or state and/or branch level by a female athlete of any age.

Male Athlete of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to competition performances at an international and/or national and/or state and/or branch level by a male athlete of any age.

Team of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) by a team in respect to lifesaving performances at an international and/or national and/or state and/or branch level. (Eg. first aid, R & R, boat crew, board rescue, patrol competition)

Coach of the Year

Outstanding lifesaving coaching performances with athletes at an international and/or national and/or state and/or branch level. Please note that no paid coach will be considered for this award.

Champion Surf Sports Club

The club accumulating the most points at the Branch championships.



Club of the Year

This award is based on the entire club performance. Lifesaving, administration and finance, surf sports, membership development and branch involvement.

Patrolling Club of the Year

This award is based on outstanding life saving service by a club.

Administrator of the Year

Outstanding conduct of administration of a club and/or activity. Please note that no salaried administrator will be considered for this award.

Age Manager of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to age management at junior level.

Masters Athlete of the Year

Outstanding achievement(s) in respect to competition performances at national and/or state and/or branch level by a member 30 years plus of a club.

Educator of the Year

Outstanding contribution(s) in respect to any form of Surf Life Saving Education including training, assessing and facilitating.
