Illawarra and South Coast Branches are pleased to announce the staging of the 6th annual Sydney Water Surf Club Premiership. This exciting series will once again be conducted over 5 premiership rounds, involving all age groups from Under 8's to Masters.

Competitors and Clubs will be eligible to win over \$20,000 in cash and prizes across all competition categories.

Entries:

All entries must be submitted on the attached entry form.
Please complete separate forms for junior and senior entries.

All competitors must fulfil the normal membership, award proficiency and patrol requirements, for competition as set down by SLSA.

Entry Fees are:

- Juniors \$35.00 (inc GST)
- Seniors \$40.00 (inc GST)

The entry fee includes a souvenir race singlet, and covers entry to all rounds of the series.

Initial club entries close on Monday the 15th of October 2007

Entries must include a cheque covering the entry fees prior to the closing date. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the correct monies.
Cheques are to be made payable to "Surf Life Saving Illawarra"

Further Entries & Entries on the Day

No further entries will be accepted at the office after the closing date. All additional entries will be on the day of competition only

Entries on the day of competition will attract an additional processing fee of \$10.00 for both junior and senior entries.

Officials

Each Club must supply 1 official per 10 competitors. These officials must be listed on the attached officials nomination form and submitted with the entries.

If this official, or an adequate substitute, is not present then the club shall not be permitted to compete.

Clubs that do not complete the attached officials list will have their entry forms returned.

General Event Conditions:

- All events will be conducted as per the current competition handbook.
- All competitors, (except vets) must compete in the sponsors' souvenir race singlet.
- Age Groups must be marked on the shoulder of each competitor
- For the purposes of this event the Veteran Category is defined as 35 yrs or older as at September 30th 2007.
- This years series will be have a total of 5 rounds. The juniors will participate in 4 rounds, and the seniors will participate in 4 rounds
- The junior series will be completed at the end of round 4.
- The seniors series will be completed at the end of round 5
- The juniors will have their own presentation immediately after the completion of their events at round 4; the seniors and overall prizes will be awarded at a presentation at the completion of round 5.
- The pointscore for all event events will be as follows;
 - 1st – 10 pts
 - 2nd – 7 pts
 - 3rd – 5pts
 - 4th – 4 pts
 - 5th – 3pts
 - 6th – 2pts
- All events will be of the same value; no bonus or double point events will be held.
- Under 17 Ski events will be held in this years series. All competitors in this event must have turned 16 before competing in any ski race. It is the responsibility of clubs to be able to positively prove the date of birth of any competitor should the officials require that proof.
- If such proof can not be supplied, officials are within their rights to deny that competitor a start until that proof is provided

List of Events:

Attached is a general list of events that will be conducted across the 5 rounds. The list is in the proposed order of events, but is subject to change on the day. Additionally some events may be added or deleted for various rounds throughout the series. Any changes will be notified at the time of change

Also attached is a description of the format of the combined club events.

Series Format:

The Sydney Water Surf Club Premiership will be conducted over 5 rounds within the South Coast and Illawarra Branches.

The series is designed to conduct a series of individual point score championships in addition to an overall club championship. It will cover all age categories from Under 9 to Veterans.

Please note: Under 8 events will be held but we will not be conducting a championship in these age groups. These events will also be excluded from the overall club championship.

The individual championships are open to any competitor throughout Australia, whilst the overall club championship prize money can only be won by clubs from the South Coast and Illawarra Branches.

Dates & Venues:

The four rounds will be held at the following locations:

- Round 1: Junior & Senior Saturday 20th October 2007 at Bellambi
- Round 2: Junior & Senior Sunday 28th October 2007 at Warilla
- Round 3: Junior & Senior Saturday 3rd November 2007 at Stanwell Park
- Round 4: **Junior's only** Saturday 22nd December at Thirroul (**Junior final**)
- Round 5: **Seniors only** Saturday 12th January 2008 at Thirroul (**Senior final**)

Report times are:

- 8.00 am for junior competitors
- 11.30 am for senior events
- 10:00 am for senior competitors at the senior final

Club Premiership:

The overall club championship winner will be decided on the overall point score from all events conducted across the 5 rounds.

Under 8 events are excluded from the overall club point score.

1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters in the overall championship will receive trophies and prizes.

The champion club will also receive the 2007/08 Premiership Pennant.

Individual Age Championships:

The series will also conduct individual age championships in all age groups other than Under 8's. The categories for Under 9's through to Open shall be:

- Male Water Champion
- Female Water Champion
- Male Beach Champion
- Female Beach Champion

The Masters category will only have overall Male and Female champions.

The various Age Water Champions will only accrue points from those individual age groups water events.

The various Beach Champions will only accrue points from those individual age groups beach events.

Each age champion will receive a trophy and prizes.

Open Competitors Prize money:

The Sydney Water series will continue to make prize money available to open competitors for the 2006 event.

This season the winner of every open individual event will win prize money. The total pool available to open competitors will be approximately \$8,000.

Place getters in the open Iron person will also win prize money.

SYDNEY WATER SURF PREMIERSHIP MIXED TEAM EVENT RULES

Lifesaver Relay

Teams will consist of:

- 1 Swimmer; 1 Board Paddler; 1 Ski Paddler
(Require 3 from U15, U17, U19 & Open. Max 1 open competitor)
- 1 Runner - Under 11
- 1 Runner - Under 12
- 1 Runner - Either Under 13 or 14
(Minimum 3 Females, but only 2 allowed as runners)

Course will be same as Open Ironman/Taplin;

Maximum 2 teams per club

All Age Beach Relay

Teams shall consist of: -

- 1 Competitor from each of the following age groups
U/8,U/9,U/10,U/11,U/12,U/13,U/14,U15,U17,U/19,Open, Vet
(Minimum 4 Females)

Course 70mtrs

Rules as per Competition Hand Book

Maximum 1 Team Per Club
